EXHIBITORS AND OWNERS OF TERRIERS ENTERED MUST BE CURRENT JRTCA MEMBERS

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season to be refunded with vet certificate from owner, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation.
*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed / neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation Division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by Stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground/Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site.
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office 410-561-3655; or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA Sanctioned Trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious diseases.
23. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION(S) CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!**

IMPORTANT TRIAL INFORMATION

Please familiarize yourself with the notes and rules listed below. Everything will run more smoothly if everyone knows the information provided.

As of Jan. 1, 2010, all competing terriers must be registered or recorded with the JRTCA. If your terrier has not been registered or recorded, you will have to pay an additional \$5.00 per dog per day. You will still have to pay the normal \$2.00 per dog per day JRTCA Administration Fee. Both fees are turned in to the JRTCA.

*****ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JUNE 24, 2017*****

All entries postmarked after 06/24/2017 will be considered post-entries, and you will be charged accordingly. No Exceptions! NO PHONE ENTRIES. Entries may be emailed (or regular mail) to the Trial Secretary at plrjacks@gmail.com, along with copies of your current JRTCA Membership card, & any applicable Certificates. If you email your entry, you will receive a confirmation email, if you have not received one by July 1, please contact the Trial Secretary.

CERTIFICATES: Please include copies of the necessary certificates with your pre-entries for the Working Division, GTG, Super Earth and any other class(es) requiring certificates. The trial secretary makes no assumptions. If the appropriate certificate is not included, your dog will be entered in the open class -- NOT the certificate class.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS WHILE AT THE TRIAL SITE

If you see someone who does not, politely offer them a baggie.

REMINDER: Please follow the rules of your hotel/accommodations regarding your terriers; clean up after them on the grounds and please be a good representative of your club.

It is the intent of club members to provide a trial that is enjoyable for all participants. As a result, **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** at any time. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship, rude behavior or causing trouble in any manner will be dismissed from all classes and asked to leave the trial grounds. No refunds will be given in this situation.

NO RACING POST ENTRIES, Except as available to fill heats!

MEASUREMENTS of borderline-sized terriers or disputed terriers will be performed by a sanctioned judge a minimum of 30 minutes before **Racing** or **Conformation** starts. Conformation measurements will be performed by the Conformation judge or their designee ****before**** the start of Conformation classes. The judge, however, may call for a measurement once a class begins. Measurements made at this time will be considered the terriers' official height for the duration of the trial.

RINGSIDE SPACE: Available for the weekend for \$30.00 Members / \$35.00 Non-Members for a 10 X 10 space. Ringside seating will be assigned.

SPONSORSHIPS: Please sign up to sponsor a class. Sponsorships help pay for ribbons, trophies, judges and other trial expenses. See included sponsorship form.

VENDORS ARE WELCOME FOR THE WEEKEND! There is a \$25 fee. Please indicate on your entry form if you would like a vendor space.

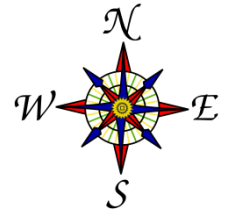

From the I-5 South

- Take the third Chehalis Exit #79, Chamber Way. Turn right off the exit onto Chamber Way.
- Go to the second stop light and turn left onto National Avenue, which is a one-way street going north. National Avenue turns into Kresky Avenue.
- For the South Entrance and South Parking Lot, turn left on Exhibitor Road.
- Turn left at the next stop sign onto National Avenue. You will want to get into the right lane immediately for the fair office or the South Parking Lot.
- For the North Parking Lot, continue north on Kresky Avenue and turn left on Fair Street, then left on Gold Street. The North Parking Lot will be on the right side. From the I-5 North
- Exit I-5 at Centralia Exit 82 (Harrison St. Exit) pass through the light onto the distributor lane running parallel with I-5. Continue through the light at Mellen St.
- Follow the horseshoe curve to the left, crossing over the I-5, there is a stop light. Go through the light (curves to the left) and continue down to next light at the bottom, turn right onto Mellen Street.
- Drive approximately six blocks to the second stop light.
- Turn right on Pearl Street (one-way street going south).
- Cross over the viaduct and Pearl Street turns into Gold Street. Proceed south on Gold Street, and it turns into National Avenue. You will see the fairgrounds on the right side. Enter on the South Gate Entrance.

DIVISION A: RACING

- Terriers must run in Flats & Steeplechase races to compete in Championship races.
- No cross-entering between regular Adult, Veteran, or Senior classes, or between sanctioned and non-sanctioned classes.
- Seniors run over low hurdles, up to 8 inches.
- **ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED!** Plastic basket muzzles or closed-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight or open-ended muzzles.
- **ATTENTION: NEW JRTCA RULE FOR RACING MUZZLES – NO COLORED BASKET MUZZLES ALLOWED. NO Exceptions.** Acceptable muzzles are Black, Tan, or white. (Cloth muzzles are not affected by this rule).
- Races will be run in the exact sequence posted in this Trial Premium.
- **HAVE YOUR TERRIER ON DECK AND MUZZLED!** Listen for class announcements! If you need assistance please ask; we are here to help. **BE CONSIDERATE OF OTHER COMPETITORS.**
- **4-6 month puppies do not qualify for Puppy Championship.**

Section 1. Flat Races

- Class 1: **Pups**, 4 to 6 months (**Non-Sanctioned**)
- Class 2: **Pups**, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12 ½"
- Class 3: **Pups**, 6 up to 9 months, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 4: **Pups**, 9 up to 12 months, up to 12 ½"
- Class 5: **Pups**, 9 up to 12 months, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 6: **Dogs**, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 7: **Dogs**, 1 year and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 8: **Bitches**, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 9: **Bitches**, 1 year and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 10: **Veteran Dogs**, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 11: **Veteran Dogs**, 6 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 12: **Veteran Bitches**, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 13: **Veteran Bitches**, 6 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 14: **Senior Dogs**, 9 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 15: **Senior Dogs**, 9 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 16: **Senior Bitches**, 9 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 17: **Senior Bitches**, 9 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 18: **Other Breed**, Open to any breed other than a JRT that is between 10" & 15" (**Non-Sanc**)

Section 2. Steeplechase Races

Puppy and Senior terriers race over low hurdles, up to 8". We run the Steeplechase and Championship races for the Puppy and Senior classes back to back since they use the same 8" jump height limit. Adult and Veteran Races over higher hurdles, over 8" up to 16". **No 4-6 month Puppy Steeplechase Races.**

- Class 19: **Pups**, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12 ½"
- Class 20: **Pups**, 6 up to 9 months, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 21: **Pups**, 9 up to 12 months, up to 12 ½"
- Class 22: **Pups**, 9 up to 12 months, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 23: **Senior Dogs**, 9 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 24: **Senior Dogs**, 9 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"

- Class 25: **Senior Bitches**, 9 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 26: **Senior Bitches**, 9 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 27: **Up to 12 ½" PUPPY RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of classes 2, 4, 19 & 21. **No Entry Fee**
- Class 28: **Over 12 ½" up to 15" PUPPY RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of classes 3, 5, 20, & 22. **No Entry Fee**.
- Class 29: **10" Up To 12 ½" SENIOR RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of Classes 14, 16, 23 & 25. **No entry fee**
- Class 30: **Over 12 ½" Up To 15" SENIOR RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of Classes 15, 17, 24 & 26. **No entry fee**.

(Races are over higher hurdles, over 8" up to 16")

- Class 31: **Dogs**, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½"
- Class 32: **Dogs**, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 33: **Bitches**, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12½"
- Class 34: **Bitches**, 1 year and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 35: **Veteran Dogs**, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"
- Class 36: **Veteran Dogs**, 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 37: **Veteran Bitches**, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12½"
- Class 38: **Veteran Bitches**, 6 years and older, over 12½" up to 15"
- Class 39: **Other Breed**, Open to any breed other than a JRT that is between 10" & 15" **(Non-Sanc)**
- Class 40: **10" up to 12 ½" ADULT RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of classes 6, 8, 31 & 33 **No Entry Fee**.
- Class 41: **Over 12 ½" up to 15" ADULT RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of classes 7, 9, 32 & 34 **No Entry Fee**.
- Class 42: **10" up to 12 ½", VETERANS RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of classes 10, 12, 35 & 37 **No Entry Fee**.
- Class 43: **Over 12 ½" up to 15", VETERANS RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of classes 11, 13, 36 & 38 **No Entry Fee**.

DIVISION B: CHILD & YOUTH

Child and Youth Handler classes will be the first Conformation classes in the ring. Child Handler will go first followed by Youth Handler, then Conformation.

The Child/Youth Handler program must handle the SAME terrier in all the Child/Youth Division classes entered. The intention of this Division is for the Child/Youth to have a positive experience. They should have a basic knowledge of the history of the Jack Russell Terrier as well. This information is available on the Jack Russell Terrier Club Of America's website. www.therealjackrussell.com.

Go-To-Ground

Reminder!

For those terriers entered in the Child/Youth Handler Division and in the Go-To-Ground Division, please remember that the terrier MUST run their SANCTIONED Go-To-Ground class BEFORE the Child/Youth Handler Go-To-Ground classes.

- Class 44: **Child Handler** – Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child’s ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of terrier is NOT to be considered.
- Class 45: **Child Go-To-Ground (NON-SANCTIONED)** – Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. Judged on the child’s ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10- foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.
- Class 46: **CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE (NON-SANCTIONED) – Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner-up in Classes 44 & 45.** The points are awarded as follows: 1st=8 points, 2nd=6 points, 3rd=5 points, 4th=4 points, 5th=3 points, 6th=2 points; and participation = 1 point. **No Entry Fee**
- Class 47: **Youth Handler** – Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth’s ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier.
- Class 48: **Youth Go-To-Ground** – Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth’s ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.
- Class 49: **YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE – Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in Classes 47 & 48.** The points are awarded as follows: 1st=8 points, 2nd=6 points, 3rd=5 points, 4th=4 points, 5th=3 points, 6th=2 points; and participation = 1 point. **No Entry Fee**

NOTE: Child Handlers & Youth Handlers must compete in either Child Handler & Child G-T-G or Youth Handler & Youth GTG to qualify for Child Handler High Score & Reserve or Youth Handler High Score & Reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring; the Judge to be decided by the Trial Administrator.

- Class 57: Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months
- Class 58: **Best Puppy Bitch & Reserve – Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Classes 56 & 57. No Entry Fee.**

Section 3. JRTCA Working Terrier Conformation

Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC). Terriers entering the Working Section may not cross-enter into the Open Section; no cross-entering is permitted within the Working Section.

- Class 65: **Bronze Medallion Bitch** – Open to any bitch which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion For Special Merit In The Field.
- Class 66: **Working Terrier Bitch**, 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 67: **Working Terrier Bitch**, over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 68: **Working Veteran Bitch**, open to any bitch 6 years and older
- Class 69: **Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve – Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Classes 65-68. No Entry Fee.**
- Class 70: **WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE – Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Classes 64 & 69. No Entry Fee.**

Section 4. Open Adult Conformation

No cross-entering is permitted within the Open Section. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open Section and the Working Section.

- Class 77: **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch** – Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.
- Class 78: **Bitches, 1 year and older**, 10" up to 12.5", smooth
- Class 79: **Bitches, 1 year and older**, 10" up to 12.5", rough/broken
- Class 80: **Bitches, 1 year and older**, over 12.5" up to 15", smooth
- Class 81: **Bitches, 1 year and older**, over 12.5" up to 15", rough/broken
- Class 82: **BEST BITCH & RESERVE – Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Classes 77-81. No Entry Fee.**

Section 5. Breeders' Classes

(SANCTIONED)

Open to Stud Dog and Get and Brood Bitch and Produce. Must have at least two, but no more than three offspring at parent's side. Stud Dog and Brood Bitch must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type.

Class 85: **Stud Dog & Get**

Class 86: **BEST FAMILY & RESERVE – Open to 1st and 2nd place winners from Classes 88 & 89. No Entry Fee. (Non-sanc)**

Section 6. Miscellaneous

(SANCTIONED UNLESS NOTED)

Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier including those spayed and neutered. Those that are intact may enter the Miscellaneous Classes and may cross-enter into regular Conformation. Judged on breed standard and condition of the dog, unless otherwise noted.

Class 87: **Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier** – Open to any adult spayed/neutered JRT which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. NHC to be provided with entry form or at time of class.

Class 88: **Spayed/Neutered Terrier** – Open to any adult JRT which has been neutered or spayed).

Class 89: **Novice Terrier** – Open to any adult JRT which has never placed 1st - 4th in an adult regular or 1st in any Novice Conformation Class at this or ANY prior sanctioned trial).

Class 90: **Tri-State Bred** – Open to any adult JRT bred in the Tri-State area.

Class 91: **Veteran Terrier** – Open to any JRT 6 years and older. Judged on Breed Standard and condition of the terrier. (Applies to the Veteran & Senior High Point)

Class 92: **Companion & Rescue Terrier** – Open to any Jack Russell Terrier or working breed AND any rescue or foster dog. (Applies to the Companion & Rescue High Point) **(Non-Sanc)**

Section 7. Suitability – Judge's Choice

(SANCTIONED)

Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier, including those which have been spay/neutered. The dog the Judge would choose to take hunting to each quarry listed below.

Class 93: **Suitability to Red Fox**

Class 94: **Suitability to Groundhog**

Class 95: **Suitability to Raccoon/Badger**



DIVISION D: GO-TO-GROUND

Section 1. Open Go-To-Ground **(Sanctioned, unless otherwise noted)**

- Class 96: **Pre-Novice Puppy** – Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 to 6 months of age. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 97: **Novice Puppy** – Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another -- examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)
- Class 98: **Open Puppy** – Open to Jack Russells 6 to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies that have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another.)
- Class 99: **PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP** – Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and with-out leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another.)
- Class 100: **Novice Adult** – Open to JRTs 1 year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another -- examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)
- NOTE: If a terrier has passed the Novice Puppy class or Novice Adult class, the terrier may not enter ANY Novice class ever again***
- Class 101: **Open Adult** – Open to Jack Russells 1 year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to an-other.)
- Class 102: **Other Breed Go-To-Ground (Non-Sanctioned)** Open to any breed other than a JRT, under 30 lbs. May Not cross-enter with any Sanctioned GTG Class.

No adult terrier may compete in any GTG or Super Earth Certificate class unless a JRTCA Trial Certificate has been applied for, issued, AND presented to the Trial Secretary with the submission of entry forms or at the trial.

Section 2. GO-TO-GROUND CHAMPION CERTIFICATE

CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES

- Class 103: **10" up to 12 ½" Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 1 year and older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 104: **Over 12 ½ up to 15" Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 12½" up to 15", 1 year and older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 105: **10" up to 12 ½" Veteran Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 6 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 106: **Over 12 ½" up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 6 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 107: **10" up to 12.5" Senior Champion Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 9 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 108: **Over 12.5" up to 15" Senior Champion Certificate Senior Champion Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 9 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).



DIVISION E: SUPER EARTH

Section 1. Open Super Earth

(SANCTIONED, unless otherwise noted)

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached; must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

Open Super Earth Classes are NOT Champion Classes. *You must pass the Open class and submit your paperwork to the JRTCA to compete in the Super Earth Certificate Classes at future trials.*

Class 109: **6 up to 12 months Puppy Super Earth**

Class 110: **10" – 15" Adult Super Earth** – Open to adult terriers one year and older.

Class 111: **10" – 15" Veteran Super Earth** – Open to veteran terriers 6 years and older.

Class 112: **10" – 15" Senior Super Earth** – Open to senior terriers 9 years and older.

Class 113: **Other Breed Super Earth** – Open to any breed other than a JRT, 10" – 15", under 30 lbs. May Not cross-enter with any Sanctioned Super Earth Class. **(Non-Sanctioned)**

Section 2. SUPER EARTH CERTIFICATE CLASSES

(SANCTIONED)

No Cross-Entering Between Open and Certificate Classes

Open to adult Jack Russells one year and older which hold a **JRTCA SUPER EARTH Trial Certificate**. A copy of the Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Registration Desk with post-entry. First and second place winners will be Super Earth Champion and Reserve. **(30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached; must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.)**

Class 114: **6 up to 12 Month Puppy Championship Super Earth.** Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 Month Super Earth Puppy Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with Pre-Entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 115: **10" up to 12.5" Adult Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.

Class 116: **Over 12.5" up to 15" Adult Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells one year and older which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.

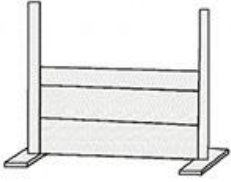
Class 117: **10" up to 12.5" Veteran Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 6 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.

Class 118: **Over 12.5" up to 15" Veteran Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 6 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.

Class 119: **10" up to 12.5" Senior Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 9 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.

Class 120: **Over 12.5" up to 15" Senior Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 9 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.

DIVISION F: OBEDIENCE



There is no requirement in the JRTCA that a dog must progress from Pre-Novice to Novice to Open, earning three qualifying scores in a class before being permitted to enter the next higher one. Dogs may be entered in any class for which they are eligible, except where cross entering is not permitted. Open to Jack Russell Terriers 6 months of age and older.

- Class 121: **Pre-Novice Obedience "A"** All exercises performed on-leash. Judged individually: heel, figure 8, stand for exam, recall, one minute sit or down. Pre Novice "A" is open to dogs that do not hold a Pre-Novice title or dogs that do not show Obedience in other venues. Not eligible for the Championship.
- Class 122: **Pre-Novice Obedience "B"** All exercises performed on-leash. Judged individually: heel, figure 8, stand for exam, recall, one minute sit or down. Pre Novice "B" is open to dogs that have a good knowledge of obedience or hold a Pre Novice title. This class is eligible for the championship and may cross enter into Novice and Open as desired. Eligible for a Pre-Novice "B" Obedience Certificate upon completion of 3 qualifying scores.
- Class 123: **Novice Obedience** Judged individually: heel on-leash, figure 8 off-leash, stand for exam off-leash, recall off-leash, sit or down stay off-leash while handler walks a T-pattern. Eligible for a Novice Obedience Certificate upon completion of 3 qualifying scores. May cross enter into Pre-Novice "B" and Open.
- Class 124: **Open Obedience** All exercises performed off-leash. Judged individually: heel, figure 8, drop on recall, retrieve on flat, retrieve over high jump, broad jump, and go-out. Eligible for an Open Obedience Certificate upon completion of 3 qualifying scores. May cross enter into Novice & Pre-Novice "B"
- Class 125: **OBEDIENCE CHAMPION & RESERVE** The dogs with the two highest combined scores from the Pre-Novice "B", Novice Obedience, or Open Obedience Classes will be Obedience Trial Champion and Reserve. Ties shall be broken by each team again performing the Off-Leash Heeling Pattern exercise. Addition-Note: Two of the three classes are acceptable for Championships.
- Class 126: **Pre-Novice (Other Breed)** Open to any breed other than a JRT. All exercises performed on-leash. Judged individually: heel, figure 8, stand for exam, recall, one minute sit or down. **(Non-Sanc)**
- Class 127: **Novice (Other Breed)** Open to any breed other than a JRT. Judged individually: heel on-leash, figure 8 off-leash, stand for exam off-leash, recall off-leash, sit or down stay off-leash while handler walks a T-pattern. **(Non-Sanc)**

DIVISION G: RALLY OBEDIENCE

(Sanctioned Unless Noted Otherwise)

- Class 128: **Companion Rally** Open to Jack Russell Terriers 6 months and older. Performed on-lead. Same course as Rally I. This class is for the companion terrier that has little or no formal Obedience training. A true beginner class. May not cross-enter in any other rally classes.
- Class 129: **Rally I** Open to Jack Russell Terriers 6 months of age and older. Numbered course performed on loose lead at a normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. May cross-enter into Rally II.
- Class 130: **Rally II** Open to Jack Russell Terriers 6 months of age and older. Performed off-lead. Numbered course with different or added exercises of more difficulty. May cross-enter into Rally I.



Class 131: **RALLY CHAMPION & RESERVE** To be awarded to the terrier and runner up with the two highest combined scores from Rally I & Rally II. No entry fee. **(Non-Sanc)**

Class 132: **Rally I (Other Breed)** Open to any breed other than a JRT. Performed on-lead. Numbered course, performed on loose lead at a normal walking pace. Must have some knowledge of Obedience. **(Non-Sanctioned)**

DIVISION H: TRAILING & LOCATING

Section 1. (SANCTIONED)

Trailing & Locating involves the terrier tracking and locating a quarry (above ground). The terrier is judged on his ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on quarry. The terrier is judged on a combination of time and accuracy. The terrier with the fastest time is not necessarily the winner.

Class 133: **Puppies, 6 up to 12 months**

Class 134: **Adults, 1 year and older**

Class 135: **Veterans, 6 years and older**

Class 136: **Seniors, 9 years and older**

Section 2. (NON-SANCTIONED)

This event is for any breed other than a JRT, i.e. Colored Terriers/Working Breeds, etc. May **NOT** cross-enter with any Sanctioned Trailing & Locating Classes

Class 137: **Puppies, 6 up to 12 months**

Class 138: **Adults, 1 year and older**



DIVISION I: NON-SANCTIONED FUN CLASSES

Section 1: EXTREME BRUSH HUNT (NON-SANCTIONED)

A new, fun twist on Brush Hunt that you and your dog will love! The event will be a simulated “Brush Hunt” situation with multiple locations that the dog can access and check for quarry. The dog has 2 minutes to find as many of the 6 hidden tubes containing live rats as they can. There will also be 2 tubes containing just rat litter/bedding and your dog will need to discriminate between the live and litter/bedding tubes. Points will be accumulated for each live tube found and also when the dog completes simple obstacles on the course. Points are deducted for falsely marking a litter tube. Score sheets will be included in your entry packet, please bring it with you to the class.

Class 139: **Puppies, 6 up to 12 months**

Class 140: **Adults, 1 year and older**

Class 141: **Veterans, 6 years and older**

Class 142: **Seniors, 9 years and older**

Class 143: **Other breed**, Open to any breed other than a JRT.

DIVISION J: SPECIAL WEEKEND HIGH POINTS

Open to adult Terriers 1 year and older, MUST compete in Working or Open Conformation (Division C, Sections 3 or 4), plus at least four additional classes from these events: Go-to-Ground, Super Earth, Racing Flats, Racing Hurdles, Obedience, Rally, Trailing & Locating & Extreme Brush Hunt.


