Exhibitors and Owners of Terriers Entered Must Be Current JRTCA Members

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season to be refunded with vet certificate from owner, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation.
*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed / neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation Division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by Stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground/Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RVs & campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds).
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office 410-561-3655; or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.terrier.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA Sanctioned Trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious diseases.
23. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION(S) CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!**

IMPORTANT TRIAL INFORMATION

Please familiarize yourself with the notes and rules listed below. Everything will run more smoothly if everyone knows the information provided.

As of Jan. 1, 2010, all competing terriers must be registered or recorded with the JRTCA. If your terrier has not been registered or recorded, you will have to pay an additional \$5.00 per dog per day. You will still have to pay the normal \$2.00 per dog per day JRTCA Administration Fee. Both fees are turned in to the JRTCA.

*****ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JUNE 22, 2019*****

All entries postmarked after 06/22/2019 will be considered post-entries, and you will be charged accordingly. No Exceptions. NO PHONE ENTRIES. Entries can be emailed to the Trial Secretary at plrjacks@gmail.com, (or regular mail - see entry form), along with copies of your current JRTCA Membership card, & any applicable Certificates. All emailed entries will receive a confirmation email (if one is provided), if you have not received your confirmation by June 30, please contact the Trial Secretary.

CERTIFICATES: Please include copies of the necessary certificates with your pre-entries for the Working Division, GTG, Super Earth and any other class(es) requiring certificates. The trial secretary makes no assumptions. If the appropriate certificate is not included, your dog will be entered in the open class -- NOT the certificate class.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS WHILE AT THE TRIAL SITE

If you see someone who does not, politely offer them a baggie.

REMINDER: Please follow the rules of your hotel/accommodations regarding your terriers; clean up after them on the grounds and please be a good representative of your club.

It is the intent of club members to provide a trial that is enjoyable for all participants. As a result, **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** at any time. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship, rude behavior or causing trouble in any manner will be dismissed from all classes and asked to leave the trial grounds. No refunds will be given in this situation.

MEASUREMENTS of borderline-sized terriers or disputed terriers will be performed by a sanctioned judge a minimum of 30 minutes before **Racing** or **Conformation** starts. Conformation measurements will be performed by the Conformation judge or their designee ****before**** the start of Conformation classes. The judge, however, may call for a measurement once a class begins. Measurements made at this time will be considered the terriers' official height for the duration of the trial.

RINGSIDE SPACE: Available for the weekend for \$30.00 Members / \$35.00 Non-Members for a 10 X 10 space. Ringside seating will be assigned.

VENDORS ARE WELCOME FOR THE WEEKEND! There is a \$25 fee. Please indicate on your entry form if you would like a vendor space.

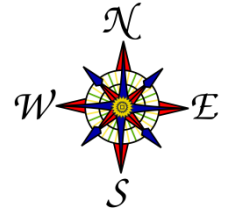

From the I-5 South

- Take the third Chehalis Exit #79, Chamber Way. Turn right off the exit onto Chamber Way.
- Go to the second stop light and turn left onto National Ave., which is a one-way street going north. National Ave. turns into Kresky Ave.
- For the South Entrance and South Parking Lot, turn left on Exhibitor Rd.
- Turn left at the next stop sign onto National Ave. You will want to get into the right lane immediately for the fair office or the South Parking Lot.
- For the North Parking Lot, continue north on Kresky Ave. and turn left on Fair St, then left on Gold St. The North Parking Lot will be on the right side.

From the I-5 North

- Exit I-5 at Centralia Exit 82 (Harrison St. Exit) pass through the light onto the distributor lane running parallel with I-5. Continue through the light at Mellen St.
- Follow the horseshoe curve to the left, crossing over I-5, there is a stop light. Go through the light (curves to the left) and continue down to next light at the bottom, turn right onto Mellen St.
- Drive approximately six blocks to the second stop light.
- Turn right on Pearl St (one-way street going south).
- Cross over the viaduct and Pearl St. turns into Gold St. Proceed south on Gold St, and it turns into National Ave. You will see the fairgrounds on the right side. Enter at the South Gate Entrance.

DIVISION A: RACING

- Terriers must run in Flats & Steeplechase races to compete in Championship races.
- No cross-entering between regular Adult, Veteran, or Senior classes, or between sanctioned and non-sanctioned classes.
- Seniors run over low hurdles, up to 8 inches.
- **ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED!** Plastic basket muzzles or closed-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight or open-ended muzzles, no Baskervilles.
- **ATTENTION: JRTCA RULE FOR RACING MUZZLES – NO COLORED BASKET MUZZLES ALLOWED. NO Exceptions. Acceptable muzzles are Black, Tan, or White.** (Cloth muzzles are not affected by this rule). NO Baskervilles.
- Races will be run in the exact sequence posted in this Trial Premium.
- Have your terrier on deck and muzzled. Listen for class announcements! If you need assistance please ask; we are here to help. Please be considerate of other competitors.
- **3-4 & 4-6 month puppies do not run hurdles or qualify for Puppy Championship.**

Section 2. Steeplechase Races

Puppy and Senior terriers race over low hurdles, up to 8". We run the Steeplechase and Championship races for the Puppy and Senior classes back to back since they use the same 8" jump height limit. Adult and Veteran Races over higher hurdles, over 8" up to 16". **No 3-4 or 4-6 month Puppy Steeplechase Races.**

DIVISION B: CHILD & YOUTH

Child and Youth Handler classes will be the first Conformation classes in the ring. Child Handler will go first followed by Youth Handler, then Conformation.

The Child/Youth Handler program must handle the SAME terrier in all the Child/Youth Division classes entered. The intention of this Division is for the Child/Youth to have a positive experience. They should have a basic knowledge of the history of the Jack Russell Terrier as well. This information is available on the Jack Russell Terrier Club Of America's website. www.therealjackrussell.com.

**Go-To-Ground
Reminder!**

For those terriers entered in the Child/Youth Handler Division and in the Go-To-Ground Division, please remember that the terrier MUST run their SANCTIONED Go-To-Ground class BEFORE the Child/Youth Handler Go-To-Ground classes.

- Class 45 **Child Handler** – Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of terrier is NOT to be considered.
- Class 46 **Child Go-To-Ground (NON-SANCTIONED)** – Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10- foot Novice liner; time not to be considered **Non-Sanc**
- Class 47 **CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE (NON-SANCTIONED) –** **Non-Sanc**
Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner-up in Classes 45 & 46.
 The points are awarded as follows: 1st=8 points, 2nd=6 points, 3rd=5 points, 4th=4 points, 5th=3 points, 6th=2 points; and participation = 1 point. **No Entry Fee**
- Class 48 **Youth Handler** – Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier.
- Class 49 **Youth Go-To-Ground** – Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.
- Class 50 **YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE – Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in Classes 48 & 49.** The points are awarded as follows: 1st=8 points, 2nd=6 points, 3rd=5 points, 4th=4 points, 5th=3 points, 6th=2 points; and participation = 1 point. **No Entry Fee**

NOTE: Child Handlers & Youth Handlers must compete in either Child Handler & Child G-T-G or Youth Handler & Youth GTG to qualify for Child Handler High Score & Reserve or Youth Handler High Score & Reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring; the Judge to be decided by the Trial Administrator.

- Class 79 **Bred By Exhibitor Bitch – Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered or a member of the breeder's immediate family.**
- Class 80 **Bitches, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12.5", smooth**
- Class 81 **Bitches, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12.5", rough/broken**
- Class 82 **Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12.5" up to 15", smooth**

- Class 96 **Other Breed Terrier** Open to any adult “other breed Terrier”, up to 30 lbs. (Non-Sanctioned). **Non-Sanc**

- Class 103 **Open Puppy** – Open to Jack Russells 6 to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppies that have previously achieved 100% in this class. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another.)

Class 104 **PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP** – Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and with-out leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another.)

Class 105 **Novice Adult** – Open to JRTs 1 year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another -- examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

NOTE: If a terrier has passed the Novice Puppy class or Novice Adult class, the terrier may not enter ANY Novice class ever again.

Class 106 **Open Adult** – Open to Jack Russells 1 year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to an-other)

Class 107 **Other Breed Go-To-Ground (Non-Sanctioned)** Open to any breed other than a JRT, under 30 lbs. May Not cross-enter with any Sanctioned GTG Class. **Non-Sanc**

No adult terrier may compete in any GTG or Super Earth Certificate class unless a JRTCA Trial Certificate has been applied for, issued, AND presented to the Trial Secretary with the submission of entry forms or at the trial.

Section 2. GO-TO-GROUND CHAMPION CERTIFICATE

CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES

Class 108 **10" up to 12 ½" Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 1 year and older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 109 **Over 12 ½ up to 15" Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 12½" up to 15", 1 year and older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

- Class 110 **10" up to 12 ½" Veteran Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 6 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 111 **Over 12 ½" up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 6 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 112 **10" up to 12.5" Senior Champion Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 9 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 113 **Over 12.5" up to 15" Senior Champion Certificate Senior Champion Certificate** – Open to any adult Jack Russell, 9 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

DIVISION E: SUPER EARTH

Section 1. Open Super Earth **(SANCTIONED, unless otherwise noted)**

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached; must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

Open Super Earth Classes are NOT Champion Classes. *You must pass the Open class and submit your paperwork to the JRTCA to compete in the Super Earth Certificate Classes at future trials.*

First and second place winners will be Super Earth Champion and Reserve. ***(30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached; must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.)***

- Class 119 **6 up to 12 Month Puppy Championship Super Earth.** Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 Month Super Earth Puppy Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with Pre-Entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve.
- Class 120 **10" up to 12.5" Adult Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.
- Class 121 **Over 12.5" up to 15" Adult Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells one year and older which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.
- Class 122 **10" up to 12.5" Veteran Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 6 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.
- Class 123 **Over 12.5" up to 15" Veteran Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 6 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.
- Class 124 **10" up to 12.5" Senior Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 9 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.
- Class 125 **Over 12.5" up to 15" Senior Champion Super Earth Certificate** – Open to adult Jack Russells 9 years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate.

DIVISION F: TRAILING & LOCATING

Trailing & Locating involves the terrier tracking and locating a quarry (above ground). The terrier is judged on his ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark and open on quarry. The terrier is judged on a combination of time and accuracy. The terrier with the fastest time is not necessarily the winner.

Section 2. Trailing & Locating (NON-SANCTIONED)

This event is for any breed other than a JRT, i.e. Colored Terriers/Working Breeds, etc. May NOT cross-enter with any Sanctioned Trailing & Locating Classes

DIVISION G: BRUSH HUNT

(NON-SANCTIONED)

The terrier is timed from the release at the starting line until the handler signals that the quarry is found. The handler may not enter the fenced area, and may not give hand signals or any encouragement for 1 minute. After 1 minute has passed the handler may use hand signals or encouragement but must still remain behind the fence. Maximum time allowed 2 minutes. No cross-entering between veterans and seniors. **(Non-Sanctioned)**

DIVISION H: SPECIAL WEEKEND HIGH POINTS

*****NO ENTRY FEES*** (Non-Sanctioned)**

There's NO ENTRY FEE to enter the High Point classes. The more classes you enter, the more points your dog can earn! A score sheet will be included in your registration packet. You are responsible for keeping track of your points, which may be checked by the Trial Administrator in case of dispute. Please have your score sheets completed & turned in to the trial secretary, Sunday by 4:00 PM. (No cross entering between high point classes 139-144)

- Class 141 **Veteran High Point** **Non-Sanc**
 Open to Terriers 6 years and older only. MUST compete in the Veteran Terrier conformation class, Class 93 plus at least four additional classes from these events: Go-to-Ground, Super Earth, Racing Flats, Racing Hurdles, Trailing & Locating, & Brush Hunt.
- Class 142 **Senior High Point** **Non-Sanc**
 Open to Terriers 9 years and older only. MUST compete in the Veteran conformation class, Class 93, plus at least four additional classes from these events: Go-to-Ground, Super Earth, Racing Flats, Racing Hurdles, Trailing & Locating, & Brush Hunt.
- Class 143 **Companion/Rescue High Point** **Non-Sanc**
 Open to Spayed & Neutered Terriers and Rescued Terriers only. Dogs MUST compete in the Spayed/Neutered Class (Class 90 or 91), or the Companion & Rescue Terrier Conformation Class (Class 95); plus at least four additional classes from these events: Go-to-Ground, Super Earth, Racing Flats, Racing Hurdles, Trailing & Locating, & Brush Hunt.
- Class 144 **Novice Terrier/Handler High Point** **Non-Sanc**
 Open to Novice Terriers (6 months or older that has never placed 1st- 4th in a regular class at a JRT Trial being handled by a Novice Handler who is new to JRT Trials in the past 2 years) MUST compete in one Conformation class plus at least 4 additional classes from these events: Go-To-Ground, Super Earth, Racing Flats, Racing Hurdles, Trailing & Locating, & Brush Hunt.
- For ****ALL**** weekend High Point awards, points assigned for first through sixth, will be as follows: **1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 points; and participation = 1 point.** For example, if you place 3rd in Spayed/Neutered Terrier, you would give yourself one point for participation and 4 points for your placement, for a total of 5 points for that class.
