Exhibitors and Owners of Terriers Entered Must Be Current JRTCA Members (Does not apply to other breeds)

## GENERAL RULES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season to be refunded with vet certificate from owner, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family\*, Open or Working Conformation. \*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation Division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by Stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground/Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RVs & campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds).
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office 410-561-3655; or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website ([www.therealjackrussell.com](http://www.therealjackrussell.com)).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA Sanctioned Trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious diseases.
23. Judges must not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their events. (01/22)

All entries postmarked after **6/3/2024** will be considered post-entries, and you will be charged accordingly. No Exceptions. **NO PHONE ENTRIES.** Please email entries to the Trial Secretary at [PLRJACKS@gmail.com](mailto:PLRJACKS@gmail.com), (or regular mail - see entry form), along with copies of your current JRTCA Membership Certificate, & any applicable Certificates. **Emailed entries accepted until JUNE 10, 2024**, after 6/10/24 emailed entries will be considered post, and charged accordingly. All emailed entries will receive a confirmation of receipt email, if you have not received your confirmation by June 15, please contact the Trial Secretary. **THE ENTRY FORM IS ON PAGE 28** (youth entry pg 29). If paying by PayPal, please cover the fees or add 3% to your payment, any difference will be due at time of check-in.

**CERTIFICATES:** Please include copies of the necessary certificates with your pre-entries for the Working Division, GTG, Super Earth and any other class(es) requiring certificates. **The trial secretary makes no assumptions. If the appropriate certificate is not included, your dog will be entered in the open class – NOT the certificate class.**

**PLEASE REMEMBER TO PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS WHILE AT THE TRIAL SITE**

If you see someone who does not, politely offer them a baggie.

**REMINDER:** Please follow the rules of your hotel/accommodations regarding your terriers; clean up after them on the grounds, **NO grooming in the rooms, & please be a good representative of your club.**

It is the intent of club members to provide a trial that is enjoyable for all participants. As a result, **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** at any time. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship, rude behavior or causing trouble in any manner will be dismissed from all classes and asked to leave the trial grounds. No refunds will be given in this situation.

**MEASUREMENTS** of borderline-sized terriers or disputed terriers will be performed by a sanctioned judge a minimum of 30 minutes before **Racing** or **Conformation** starts. Conformation measurements will be performed by the Conformation judge or their designee **before** the start of Conformation classes. The judge, however, may call for a measurement once a class begins. Measurements made at this time will be considered the terriers' official height for the duration of the trial.

**RINGSIDE SPACE:** Available for the weekend, \$25.00 for a 10 X 10 space. Ringside Seating will be assigned. There is plenty of open space to set up; ez-ups are recommended as there is very little shade.

## DIVISION A: RACING

- **ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED!** Plastic basket muzzles or closed-ended cloth muzzles ONLY. **Figure eight, open-ended, and Baskerville muzzles are NOT allowed, No exceptions.**
- **ATTENTION: JRTCA RULE FOR RACING MUZZLES – NO COLORED MUZZLES ALLOWED. White, Black, Brown/Tan, & Clear muzzles are allowed.**
- Terriers MUST ENTER both flats & hurdles AND FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race and place first in at least one of their finals to compete in Championship races.
- A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier.
- Puppies & Seniors run over low hurdles, up to 8 inches.
- No cross-entering between regular Adult classes, Veteran classes, Senior classes, or sanctioned and non-sanctioned classes.
- Placement ribbons will be available at racing. Pick them up after your race. Champions will be announced before conformation.
- **Please HAVE YOUR TERRIER ON DECK AND MUZZLED. Please listen for class announcements! If you need assistance please ask; we are here to help.**
- **PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF OTHER COMPETITORS.**
- **3-4 and 4-6 month puppies will run a ½ track and cannot run hurdles and do not qualify for Puppy Championship.**

### Section 2. Steeplechase Races

Puppy and Senior terriers race over low hurdles, up to 8". We run the Steeplechase and Championship races for the Puppy and Senior classes back-to-back since they use the same 8" jump height limit. Adult and Veteran Races over higher hurdles, over 8" up to 16". **No 3-4 or 4-6 month Puppy Steeplechase Races.**

- Class 32 **Over 12 ½" Up To 15" SENIOR RACING CHAMPIONSHIP**. Open to the 1st place winners of Classes 16, 18, 26 & 28. **No entry fee.**

## **DIVISION B: CHILD & YOUTH**

Child and Youth Handler classes will be the first Conformation classes in the ring. Child Handler will go first followed by Youth Handler, then Conformation. **There are no fees for Child/Youth Classes.**

The Child/Youth Handler program must handle the SAME terrier in all the Child/Youth Division classes entered. The intention of this Division is for the Child/Youth to have a positive experience. They should have a basic knowledge of the history of the Jack Russell Terrier as well. This information is available on the Jack Russell Terrier Club Of America's website. **For those terriers entered in the Child/Youth Handler Division and in the Go-To-Ground Division, please remember that the terrier MUST run their SANCTIONED Go-To-Ground class BEFORE the Child/Youth Handler Go-To-Ground class(es).**

### **Reminder!**

- Class 50 **Youth Handler** – Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier.
- Class 51 **Youth Go-To-Ground** – Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.
- Class 52 **YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE** – **Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in Classes 50 & 51.** The points are awarded as follows: 1st=8 points, 2nd=6 points, 3rd=5 points, 4th=4 points, 5th=3 points, 6th=2 points; and participation = 1 point.

### **Section 1. Open Super Earth** **(SANCTIONED, unless otherwise noted)**

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached; must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

Class 122 **6 up to 12 months Puppy Super Earth** – Puppies, 6 to 12 months who have earned 100% in the Open Puppy Super Earth Class at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial **OR** may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth class at future trials. Winners of the Puppy Championship Super Earth will determine the Puppy Super Earth Champion & Reserve. **Open Puppy Super Earth Class is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth. The terrier with the fastest time is not necessarily the winner.

Your dog will run in an area with straw bales, cardboard boxes, garbage bags filled with paper, other common things found in your garage or yard, and an agility tunnel. When the judge calls you and your dog into the ring, you'll enter and go straight to the start area. You will wait there until the Judge says it is OK to start. You'll then remove your dog's collar and leash and release your dog. Your time starts when your dog's, or your feet, leave the start area. During the 2:00 minute maximum run time your dog will be required to find the rat, go through the agility tunnel, and climb up on anything in the ring stable enough for them to climb on. The three requirements can be completed in any order. You may encourage your dog to move anywhere in the ring, but you may not touch your dog, any items in the ring, or step over anything until they find the rat. Time stops when all the requirements are completed or the 2:00 minutes are up. Placement will be based on time.



There will be three hidden rat containers made of PVC pipe in the ring during each run. One will be empty, one will contain rat litter, and one will hold the rat.

When your dog finds the rat, you must let the Judge know by clearly calling RAT. If the Judge confirms that it is the rat, praise your dog for doing the right thing, then restrain your dog while the rat is moved to safety. You may then release your dog to finish any remaining requirements. If the Judge says the call is not a rat, your run is done and an NQ score will be assessed.


